An Act to prevent the committing of Abuses in the weighing and packing of Butter, in the Town and Borough of New Malton in the County of York.



Bereas great Duantities of Preamble.

Butter made and produced in several Parts of the County of York, are brought into the Town and Borough of New Malton, where there is a navigable River, in order to be from thence transported beyond the Seas, and otherwise sold and disposed of: And whereas there hath been sor Time out of mind a free Warket sor

Butter within the said Town and Bozough of New Malton; but there is not (as in some other adjacent Harkets) any particular Place provided and appointed within the said Town and Bozough, to which such Butter shall be brought, in order to be searched, weighed, and sealed before the same be sold at the said Harket; and soz want of which, great Frauds and Impositions have been made and committed by several Farmers, Dairymen, and other Persons trading in Butter, which hath tended to the Disparagement of the said Commodity, in the Warkets both at Home and Adroad, and to the great prejudice of the sair Dealer, and of the Butter Trade in general: Wherefore, sor preventing such Frauds and Abuses sor the suture, and sor the better

encouraging the faid Butter Crave; may it please Pour most Excellent Hajesty, at the humble Request of the Bozough Bailiff, and Inhabitants of the faid Bozough of New Malton, and of several other Persons reciding near the faid Bojough, that it may be enaded; and be it enacted by the King's most Excellent Bajeny, by and with the Advice and Consent of the Lords Spiritual and Temporal, and Commons, in this prefent Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, That from and after the first Day of May, which shall be in the Pear of our Lord Dne thousand seven hundred and fortp four, the Staith Yard, adjoining on a Street called Yorker's Gate, within the fair Cown and Bozough of New Malton, of such other Part of Place within the said Cown and Bozough, as the Bozough Bailist of the faid Comn and Bozough thail from time to time judge most commodious and convenient, and hall for that Purpofe, by Witting under his hand and Seal appoint, thall be every Day in the Week (except Sundays) a free and open Warker for Butter; and that it that and may be lawful for any Person of Persons to buy of sell any Butter in the faid Warket without any Diffurbance; and that from and after the faid first Day of May, all Butter brought to the faid Town of Bozough of New Malton, of to any Part of the Parish of Precinas of Old Malton, of to any Place within One Wile of the faid Town or Bozough of New Malton, in firkins, ibalf-firkins, Cubs, or other Casks, or in Pots, or other Cleffels, in order to be fold, of to be carried, exported, of water-boine from the faid Town and Bosough of New Malton, or from the Parith or Precinits of Old Malton, or Places adjacent, as afores faid, thall be brought to the faid Butter Warket before mentioned and appointed, or to be appointed as afore= faid, within the faid Cown and Bozough of New Malton, to be there viewed, fearched, weighed, and fealed with the Seal of the faid Warket, which the proper Officer for the time being, is hereby required to do; and that it that I and may be lawful to and for the faid Borough Bailiff, and his Successors, or their proper Officers for the time being, appointed, from time to time, and at all Times after the faid First Day of May, to ask, bemand, receive, and take, of and from every Person and Persons that thall being any Butter to the said Warket, or Place aforesaid, to be searched and weighed,

no more; (that is to say) for every such Firkin as aforesaid One Halfpeny, and so proportionably, for any Butter

Place where the Market is to be kept;

Duty for for the searching, weighing, and sealing thereof, the weighing, &c. several Rates and Duties herein after mentioned, and

put into every Tub or Messel containing any greater 02 leffer Quantity of Butter than one Firkin; and in case of Resusal, Regledt, og Denial of Payment, on Demand, of the faid several Rates and Prices before mentioned, the faid Bezough Bailiff, and his Successors, thall or may detain and make stay of any firkin, Walf-firkin, Cask, Pot, Cub, of Meffel of Butter, for which the faid Rates and Prices ought to be paid. until they thall be paid and latisfied for the same.

and for the further Prevention of any Fraud or Abuse Penalty for not in the Weight, or false Packing of Butter, be it further ter to Market. enacted by the Authority aforesaid, That if any Dairy: man, farmer, og other Perfon og Perfons making og trading in Butter, do of thall, from and after the faid fird Day of May, bzing any Butter in firkins, Balffirkins, of other Casks, Pots, of Mellels, as afolelaid, to the said Town of Bosough of New Malton, or to the Parish or Precincts of Old Malton, or Places adjacent, as aforesaid, to be sold, or to be carried, exported, or water-boine from thence as aforesaid, or from any Part of the River Derwent, within one Wile of the faid Town or Bosough of New Malton, and thall fell, carry away, or transport the same, before it be brought to the said Butter Market, to be there viewed, fearched, weighed, and feated; every Person so offending hall, upon Proof thereof made by one of more credible Witness of Witnelles, upon Dath before any Justice of the Peace of any of the Rivings within the said County of York, where the Offence hall be committed, forfeit for every Kirkin, half-firkin, or other Cask, Pot, or other Ceffel, the Sum of Three Shillings and four Pence; and in Default of Payment thereof upon Demand, the same shall or may be levied by Diffress and Sale of the Offender's Goods, by Warrant under the hand and Seal of any one of more Justice of Justices of the Peace of any of the Ridings within the faid County of York as aforefaid (reflozing to the Daender the Overplus, the Charges of diffraining being first deducted) and the one half of such fosseis tures wall be to the Use of the poor People inhabiting within the Parith where the Offence hall be from time to time committed, to be paid to the Churchwardens and Overleers of the Pool of and in such Parith, and the other half to the Informer of Informers.

And whereas by an Act of Parliament made in the Act 13 & 14 Thirteenth and Fourteenth Pears of the Reign of the late King Charles the Second, intituled, An Act for reforming of the Abuses committed in the Weight and false Packing of Butter, the Weight thereof is afcertained, and BB Provision

Provision is made for preventing Frauds and Abuses in the packing and making up the same, in the Manner, and under the Pains and Penalties therein mentioned; now it is further enacted by the Authority aforesaid. That if any firkin, balf-firkin, or Pot, or other Wellel of Butter, which, from and after the faid first Day of May, hall be brought to the Warket or Places aforesaid by any Farmer, Dairyman, Packer of og Dealer in Butter, Chall be found upon the fearthing and weighing thereof to be faulty or defective in the due Quantity or Quality ascertained, prescribed, and appointed by the faid last mentioned Ad, every such Farmer, Dairpman. Packer of, or Dealer in Butter, shall be liable to such Pains, Penalties, and Forfeitures as are mentioned. contained, and expressed in the said recited Ad, to be le-Limitation of vied as aforefaid; provided that every Profecution or Suit which thall be brought for any Offence committed against this Act, thall be commenced within four exonths after the Offence committed.

Penalty on Frauds.

Provided always, That the Officer or other Person fearching, &c. to be appointed for the fearching, weighing, and fealing by the Bailist. Of the faid firking, Balf-firking, or other Casks or Pots of Futter, Hall be appointed by the Bozough Bailist of the faid Cown or Bosough of New Malton for the time being, and thall be twoin at the General Quarter-fessions to be held for the Morth Riding of the faid County next after Easter pearly for the due Execution of the said Dffice.

Power of Appeal.

Provided also, That if any Person or Persons wall think him of themselves aggrieved by any Determination of any Justice of Justices of the Peace, who shall at any time act in pursuance of the Power to him given by this Aft, it that and may be lawful to and for such Person or Persons to appeal to the next General Quarter-sessions of the Peace to be held for the Riding where the faid Offence was committed; the Determination whereof hall be final and conclusive to all Parties; and they are hereby impowered to award Colls to either Party, as to them thall feem meet, in respect of such Appeal.

Proviso.

Provided also, and be it surther enacted, That nothing in this Ad contained thall extend to compel the bringing to the faid Warket, or Places aforesaid, any Clessel of Futter which shall contain but the Quantity of four Pounds of Futter, of under, of to make the same Aessels liable to the faid Duty; any thing in this Ac contained to the contrary notwithstanding.

Limitation of Actions.

and be it enacted, That in all Actions and Suits that thall be brought against any Person or Persons for what

Regis. he or they hall do in pursuance of this Act, every such Action or Suit Mall be brought within Six Months next after the Fact committed, and not afterwards; and shall be laid and brought in the faid County of York, and not elsewhere; and the Defendant of Defendants in such Action or Suit to be brought, thall and may plead the General Istue, Dot guilty, and give the special Matter General Issue, in Evidence; and in every such Case, if the Clerdist thall pass sor such Person or Persons, or that the Plaintist or Plaintists be nonsuit therein, or in case such Adion or Suit Hall be discontinued, the Person so sued thall have his double Coffs, and thall recover the same as Double Coffs, in Cases where Costs by Law are accustomed to be reconeren.

And be it surther enacted by the Authority aforesaid, That this At hall be deemed, adjudged, and taken to be a publick Act, and be judicially taken Potice of as fuch Publick Act, by all Judges, Justices, and other Persons whatsoever,

without specially pleading the same.
